



UPDATE ON OUR APPEAL FOR EARTHQUAKE RELIEF IN EASTERN REGION OF AFGHANISTAN

Dear friends,

As you may know, on 31 August 2025 at 23.47 local time, a 6+ magnitude earthquake struck Afghanistan's Nangarhar Province near the Pakistan border. According to OCHA's assessments 8,471 families in the assessed villages were directly impacted by the earthquake (almost 56,000 people), with 1,992 people killed (52% women and girls), 3,631 people injured (54% women and girls) and 8,471 homes destroyed or damaged. Additionally, the earthquake killed more than 7,000 livestock with 96% of affected households having lost food sources. The hardest-hit areas include Nurgal and Chawkay districts in Kunar, Dara-i-Nur district in Nangarhar, and parts of Laghman Province. The situation was made worse by a second powerful quake on 4th September. (Source: OCHA)

Serve Afghanistan was able to support for 237 families with Multi-Purpose Cash Assistance (MPCA) in Kunar Province on September 21, 2025. Each family received 20,000 Afghanis (approx. US\$300) and for widow-headed households 24,000 Afs (US\$360), which helped them to meet their emergency needs and cope with the situation. On the next page are a couple of stories of how this support has helped affected families.

In the coming week we will be supporting another 565 families with MPCA in Kunar and Nangarhar Provinces. In the first week of October we will be supporting another 159 families in Dara-i-Nur district of Nangarhar. The details are given in the table below. The total funds received/committed are \$342,800. We thank you all for extending your support in meeting the needs of the people affected by the earthquake.

Help for women whose husband was killed by the earthquake

Minha is 35 years old. There were seven members in her family. Her husband was killed when a big rock fell on her husband. Her two daughters were injured. Now she lives in Kunar – Norgal –camp with her relatives as her house was destroyed. She said, “At the mid night, it shook heavily, and my house was destroyed. A big rock rolled from the mountain fell on my husband and killed him. My two daughters were injured; we felt that it is the end of the world, and our lives are finished. She said she will never forget that horrible night in her life.



She was given 24,000AFN (US\$360) with Multi-Purpose Cash Assistance. She thanked Serve Afghanistan and donor support and said, “We really needed cash so that we can buy the things which is important for our life”.

Light in the darkness of life

Fared is the son of Mohammad Abas, He is 15 years old. There were seven members in his family. His father died when the earthquake struck. Now he lives in Kunar – Norgal – Awrak village camp because his house was destroyed in the earthquake.

He said, “In the night about 12 o’clock there was a heavy shake, with a sound of a blast, the roof of our house fell on us. Our neighbours who were sleeping outside of the rooms came to rescue us. All our family members were injured and my father died. I was under the fallen roof for two hours in the dark night. Later our neighbours found me and brought me out of the rubble and took me to the nearby clinic. In the morning they transferred me to the city hospital by the government helicopter due the road blockage problems”. When the team visited him there were blood stains on his face.



He was given 20,000 AFN (US\$300) with the Multi-Purpose Cash Assistance. His face lit up when he received the support. He said, “We can utilize this money to buy things according to the needs of our family”.
